

Directions

The Chellington Centre, Felmersham Road, Carlton Bedfordshire MK43 7NA

Whichever way you come to North West Bedfordshire, the last two or three miles are country roads but perfectly navigable by car, mini-bus or coach. Bon Voyage and enjoy your stay at Chellington!

Sat-Nav:

Sat-nav post code MK43 7NA St Nicholas Church can bring cars through Bedford on-route to Chellington; this is not advised due to town's poor road layout. We recommend you approach from south or south west via A421 as normal and then A428 via Turvey and Carlton. From the north, you can approach a number of ways, all reasonable. If you use the sat-nav, it will stop you 100 metres from our entrance at the 'Chellington' village sign (all that is left of Chellington is Hill Farm and a cluster of modern cottages). Go towards Carlton leaving the modern cottages now on your left for 100 meters, turn right onto long tarmac driveway (10 mph) where you'll find our free car park at end of driveway for up to 30 cars.

From M1 North/Northampton:

Come off M1 at J15 take A45 dual-carriageway.

Take the A428 sign-posted Bedford. At Turvey turn left for Carlton and Country Park. Continue into Carlton (do not take the small fork at start of village). At the crossroads in the centre of Carlton go straight on towards Felmersham - the 'Felmersham Road' out of the village. At the top of the hill on the left is the entrance road to the Centre (less than ½ mile outside Carlton). There is a long tarmac driveway (10 mph) and a free car park at end of driveway for up to 30 cars.

From the South - A421 (recommended):

Coming from the A1M (Moggerhanger), the M1 South (J13) or from Milton Keynes (J13), head towards Bedford but come off the A421 for Kempston (just south-east of Bedford) to avoid Bedford town's awful gyratory. Take the A428 (signposted Northampton). For around 8 miles, continue over 5 round-a-bouts (heading away from Bedford on the A428 towards Northampton and 'Turvey' village). At Turvey, turn right to Carlton (brown signposts to 'The Chellington Centre').

At the crossroads in the centre of Carlton, go straight on towards Felmersham - the 'Felmersham Road' out of the village and at the top of the hill, the entrance road to the Centre is on the left (less than ½ mile outside Carlton). There is a long tarmac driveway (10 mph) and a free car park at end of driveway for up to 30 cars

Floods:

Please be aware we are on a hill near a river which meanders with several horseshoes, the local roads at river crossings can flood at any time of the year, diversions are normally sign-posted. The route from Turvey or Stevington are always open.
